We can “count” on our leaders

This week we will finish reading *Vayikra* (the *Book of Leviticus*) in the *Torah* and begin reading *Bamidbar* (the *Book of Numbers*), appropriately named because it begins with yet another census, counting the Israelites on their way to the Promised Land. In comparing this week's census to previous ones in the *Torah*, we

note that the people and their leaders are being evaluated as they evolve and grow in their sense of purpose over time. In *Parashat Bamidbar* we find that the *Torah's* narrative pauses to look both backwards and forward as our ancestors are poised to complete what will ultimately become their successful journey towards freedom and independence.

It cannot be a coincidence that just two weeks ago we recently gathered during our annual congregational meeting (on Tuesday evening, May 14) to not only reflect upon where we have been and what we have

Evelyne Manes, 88, died peacefully on April 14, 2024, at Trustbridge Hospice at Bethesda Hospital East in Boynton Beach, FL. She fought a valiant fight against lung cancer. She survived lung cancer twice before in 2005 and 2011. Evelyne was born on October 27, 1935, in Leipzig, Germany, to the late Bella and George Aber. Her family moved to the United States on October 16, 1937, when she was just shy of 2 years old. Evelyne graduated from Buchtel High School in 1953. In 1950, she began dating her high school sweetheart, Marvin, whom she married on June 17, 1956. Evelyne was a stay-at-home mom to her two kids, Gregg and Ellen. She achieved a lifetime dream of graduating college in 1983. Following graduation she began a career as a volunteer at Akron Children's Hospital until moving to Florida full-time in 2002. In Florida, she volunteered for 19 years at Bethesda Hospital East. She joined the Auxiliary, even serving as president from 2010 - 2014. It was heart-breaking when Evelyne had to stop volunteering in 2021 because her poor vision prevented her from operating the cash register in the gift shop.

Evelyne is survived by her husband of over 67 years, Marvin; son Gregg (Deanna) Manes of Akron, OH; daughter Ellen Manes of Boca Raton, FL; grandchildren Alexa (Ben) Strangfeld of Hilliard, OH; and Jordan (Iva) Manes of South Euclid, OH; step grandchild Eric (Erin) Long of Wooster, OH. She also leaves her two great grandsons, Jackson and Harrison Strangfeld of Hilliard, OH; and step great grandson Porter Long of Wooster, OH.
